BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. Chapter 46, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
2	by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately
3	designated and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§46- Receipt of donation of damaged lands. Each</u>
5	county shall develop procedures for the acceptance of private
6	donations of land that has been damaged or is likely to sustain
7	damage due to natural disasters or climate change."
8	SECTION 2. Chapter 235, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
9	amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
10	designated and to read as follows:
11	" <u>§235-</u> Donation of damaged lands; tax deduction. (a)
12	There shall be allowed as a charitable deduction from gross
13	income the amount that represents the appraised value of land,
14	assessed at the time of the donation, that an individual
15	taxpayer donates to a county; provided that the land has
16	sustained or is likely to sustain damage due to natural disaster
17	or climate change.

1	(b) The director of taxation shall prepare forms as may be
2	necessary to claim a tax deduction under this section, may
3	require proof of the claim for the tax deduction, and may adopt
4	rules pursuant to chapter 91."
5	SECTION 3 New statutory material is underscored.
6	SECTION 4. This Act, upon its approval, shall apply to
7	taxable years beginning after December 31, 2020.
