- SECTION 1. Act 127, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, is
 amended by amending section 4 to read as follows:

 "SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 4 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of [\$59,616] \$
- 5 or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020
- $\mathbf{6}$ and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for
- 7 fiscal year 2020-2021 [for the] to establish, hire, and fill one
- 8 <u>full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE)</u> position of Alzheimer's disease
- ${f 9}$ and related dementia services coordinator within the executive
- 10 office on aging.
- 11 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the executive
- 12 office on aging for the purposes of this Act."
- 13 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
