A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO COLLECTIVE MEDIATION BY PHYSICIANS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of the attorney general
- 2 shall conduct a feasibility study on whether the legislature may
- 3 enact legislation to allow competing physicians to meet and
- 4 communicate in order to collectively mediate with a health
- 5 benefit plan. The study shall address any potential federal
- 6 preemption concerns and legal issues concerning federal
- 7 antitrust laws.
- 8 (b) The department of the attorney general shall submit a
- 9 report of its findings and recommendations, including any
- 10 proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty
- 11 days prior to the convening of the regular session of 2021.
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
