A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO PARKING FOR DISABLED PERSONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that currently the
- 2 minimum number of accessible parking spaces is regulated by the
- 3 2010 Americans with Disabilities Act Accessibility Guidelines.
- 4 For parking lots with five hundred or less total parking spaces,
- 5 the formula is not a percentage. Rather, the guidelines provide
- 6 brackets based on total lot size and the minimum number of
- 7 accessible spaces for each bracket.
- 8 The legislature further finds that before proceeding with a
- 9 plan to increase the number of accessible parking stalls in the
- 10 State, there should be a review of the number of disabled
- 11 parking permits issued and still in effect and consideration of
- 12 how increasing the number of accessible parking stalls would
- 13 impact different communities.
- 14 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 15 health to convene a working group to examine increasing the
- 16 number of accessible parking stalls in the State.
