A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AGRICULTURAL BUILDINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

7	exempted agricultural buildings for compliance with the

9	after reasonable notice is given, the applicable department or
10	agency may apply to the district court of the circuit in which
11	the property is located for a warrant, directed to any police
12	officer of the circuit, commanding the police officer to provide
13	sufficient aid and to assist the department or agency in gaining
14	entry onto the property to investigate exempted agricultural
15	buildings for compliance with the requirements of this section."
16	SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
17	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
18	SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on upon approval.

Agricultural Structures; Building Permit and Code Exemptions; Structure Size Limitations

Description:

Increases the maximum area for each agricultural shade cloth structure, cold frame, and greenhouse that could qualify the structure for an exemption from building permit and building code requirements. Adds language granting county enforcement authorities the right of entry to inspect and enforce violations. Effective upon approval. (SD1)
