### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CEMETERIES.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that Hawaii is one of the 2 few states that does not exempt religious institutions from

3 charging a fee to help manage the costs of having a columbarium

4 on their property. The legislature further finds that amending

5 current law regarding cemetery and funeral trusts to allow

6 religious institutions to feasibly construct and properly manage

7 a columbarium within their property or place of worship and

8 providing niches to its members for an affordable fee addresses

 ${f 9}$  our community's desire and commitment to care for the afterlife

 $10\,$  needs of deceased members and their family members. The primary

11 goal is to make it affordable for local families and their

12 respective religious institutions to provide a continuum of

13 spiritual care for their loved ones and parishioners, even in

- 8 requirements of this chapter upon proof satisfactory to the
- 9 director that it is a non-profit, tax-exempt corporation for
- 10 religious purposes administering temporalities of any church,
- 11 religious society, or denomination that intends to sell or offer
- 12 use of its property or portion thereof for the inurnment of
- 13 cremated remains of its members, adherents, and their families
- 14 and not for sale to the general public; provided that niches
- 15 shall not be sold or transferred to the general public."
- 16 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
