A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO RAW MILK.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that many people wish to
- 2 consume unpasteurized raw milk and raw milk products for various
- 3 reasons, including its taste and potential health benefits.
- 4 According to the National Conference of State Legislatures,
- 5 Arizona, California, Connecticut, Idaho, Maine, New Hampshire,
- 6 New Mexico, Nevada, Pennsylvania, South Carolina, Utah, and
- 7 Washington all permit the sale of raw milk in retail stores,
- 8 while Arkansas, Illinois, Kansas, Kentucky, Massachusetts,
- 9 Minnesota, Nebraska, New York, Oklahoma, Rhode Island, Texas,
- 10 and Wisconsin all allow the sale of raw milk on farms.
- 11 The legislature also finds that when properly produced, raw
- 12 milk remains as safe as pasteurized milk; however, raw milk has
- 13 taste and health benefits that may otherwise be destroyed in the
- 14 double pasteurization process. Additionally, raw milk contains
- 15 certain bacteria that are essential flavor components of many
- 16 cheese varieties.
