A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 202, Hawaiian Homes Commission Act,
 1920, as amended, is amended to read as follows:

3 "§202. Department officers, staff, commission, members, compensation. (a) There shall be a department of Hawaiian home 4 5 lands which shall be headed by an executive board to be known as 6 the Hawaiian homes commission. The members of the commission 7 shall be nominated and appointed in accordance with section 8 26-34, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The commission shall be composed of nine members, as follows: three shall be residents 9 10 of the city and county of Honolulu; two shall be residents of 11 the county of Hawaii one of whom shall be a resident of east 12 Hawaii and the other a resident of west Hawaii; two shall be 13 residents of the county of Maui one of whom shall be a resident 14 from the island of Molokai; one shall be a resident of the 15 county of Kauai; and the ninth member shall be [the chairman] an 16 at-large member of the Hawaiian homes commission. All members 17 shall have been residents of the State at least three years

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1	prior to their appointment [and at]. At least [four] five of
2	the members shall be [descendants of not less than one-fourth
3	part of the blood of the races inhabiting the] native Hawaiian
4	[Islands previous to 1778.] and either existing or prospective
5	lessees of Hawaiian homestead lands; provided that at least two
6	of these five members shall be on the department of Hawaiian
7	home lands waitlist for a homestead land award for housing,
8	farming, or ranching; provided further that if any commission
9	member who became a member based on the member's status as a
10	lessee or presence on the waitlist subsequently ceases to be a
11	lessee or is removed from the waitlist during the member's term,
12	the member may continue to serve on the commission until that
13	member's term expires. The members of the commission shall
14	serve without pay, but shall receive actual expenses incurred by
15	them in the discharge of their duties as [such] <u>commission</u>
16	members. The [governor] commission members shall [appoint the
17	chairman] elect a chairperson and vice chairperson of the
18	commission from among the <u>commission</u> members [thereof].
19	[The commission may delegate to the chairman such] The
20	governor shall nominate and, with the advice and consent of the
21	senate, appoint a director of Hawaiian home lands who is not a



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1 member of the commission. The director of Hawaiian home lands 2 shall exercise the duties, powers, and authority or so much 3 thereof, delegated to the director by the commission, and as may 4 be lawful or proper for the [performance of the functions vested 5 in the commission.] administration of the department. The 6 [chairman of the commission] director of Hawaiian home lands 7 shall serve in a full-time capacity. [He shall, in such 8 capacity, perform such duties, and exercise such powers and 9 authority, or so much thereof, as may be delegated to him by the 10 commission as herein provided above.] 11 The provisions of section 76-16, Hawaii Revised (b) 12 Statutes, shall apply to the positions of [first] deputy director and private secretary to the [chairman of the 13 14 commission.] director. The department may hire temporary staff 15 on a contractual basis not subject to chapters 76 and 78, Hawaii 16 Revised Statutes, when the services to be performed will assist 17 in carrying out the purposes of the Act. These positions may be 18 funded through appropriations for capital improvement program

19 projects and by the administration account, operating fund, or 20 native Hawaiian rehabilitation fund. No contract shall be for a 21 period longer than two years, but individuals hired under

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1 contract may be employed for a maximum of six years; provided 2 that the six-year limitation shall not apply if the department, 3 with the approval of the governor, determines that [such] these 4 contract individuals are needed to provide critical services for 5 the efficient functioning of the department. All other 6 positions in the department shall be subject to chapter 76, 7 Hawaii Revised Statutes. 8 All vacant and new civil service positions covered by 9 chapter 76, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be filled in 10 accordance with section 76-22.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes; 11 provided that the provisions of these sections shall be 12 applicable first to qualified persons of Hawaiian extraction." 13 SECTION 2. Section 222, Hawaiian Homes Commission Act, 14 1920, as amended, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read 15 as follows: 16 "(a) The department may make [such] expenditures and shall 17 adopt rules in accordance with chapter 91, Hawaii Revised 18 Statutes, as are necessary for the efficient execution of the 19 functions vested in the department by this Act. All 20 expenditures of the department and all moneys necessary for 21 loans made by the department, in accordance with [the provisions

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1 of] this Act, shall be allowed and paid upon the presentation of 2 itemized vouchers approved by the [chairman] chairperson of the 3 commission or the [chairman's] chairperson's designated representative. The department shall make an annual report to 4 5 the legislature of the State upon the first day of each regular 6 session and [such] any special reports as the legislature may 7 from time to time require. The [chairman] chairperson and 8 members of the commission shall give bond as required by law. 9 The sureties upon the bond and the conditions thereof shall be 10 approved annually by the governor."

SECTION 3. Section 26-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended to read as follows:

13 "§26-17 Department of Hawaiian home lands. The department
14 of Hawaiian home lands shall be headed by an executive board to
15 be known as the Hawaiian homes commission.

16 The commission shall be composed of nine members. The 17 appointment, tenure, and removal of the members and the filling 18 of vacancies on the commission shall be in accordance with 19 section 26-34 and section 202(a) of the Hawaiian Homes 20 Commission Act of 1920, as amended. The [governor] commission 21 members shall [appoint the] elect a chairperson and vice

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1 <u>chairperson</u> of the commission from among the <u>commission</u> members
2 [thereof].

3 [The commission may delegate to the chairperson such] The 4 governor shall nominate and, with the advice and consent of the 5 senate, appoint a director of Hawaiian home lands who is not a 6 member of the commission. The director of Hawaiian home lands 7 shall exercise the duties, powers, and authority, or so much 8 thereof, delegated to the director by the commission, and as may 9 be lawful or proper $[\tau]$ for the [performance of the functions 10 vested in the commission.] administration of the department. 11 The [chairperson of the board] director of Hawaiian home 12 lands shall serve in a full-time capacity [and shall perform 13 such duties, and exercise such powers and authority, or so much 14 thereof as may be delegated to the chairperson by the board]. 15 The department shall administer the Hawaiian Homes 16 Commission Act of 1920 as set forth in the Constitution of the 17 State and by law.

18 The functions and authority heretofore exercised by the 19 Hawaiian homes commission as heretofore constituted are 20 transferred to the department of Hawaiian home lands established 21 by this chapter."

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1 SECTION 4. Any sitting Hawaiian homes commission member 2 whose term of office has not expired as of the effective date of 3 this Act and who does not qualify to be a member of the Hawaiian 4 homes commission under the amendments made by this Act may 5 continue to serve on the commission until that member's term 6 expires.

7 SECTION 5. The incumbent who occupies the position of 8 chairperson of the Hawaiian homes commission on the effective 9 date of this Act shall continue to serve in that capacity with 10 all the powers and duties appertaining thereto prior to the 11 effective date of this Act until a director of Hawaiian home 12 lands is nominated and, subject to the advice and consent of the 13 senate, appointed pursuant to section 26-17, Hawaii Revised 14 Statutes. Beginning on the day the director of Hawaiian homes 15 lands is so appointed, the chairperson shall no longer receive a 16 salary and the director shall receive the salary formerly 17 assigned to the chairperson.

18 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
19 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
20 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

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Report Title:

Department of Hawaiian Home Lands; HHC; Chairperson; Director

Description:

Requires at least 5 Hawaiian Homes Commission members to be native Hawaiian or current Hawaiian homestead lessees; and at least 2 of those 5 to be on the waitlist for Hawaiian home lands. Authorizes commission members to elect a chairperson and vice chairperson. Creates the position of Director of Hawaiian Home Lands and separates the Director's responsibilities from those of the Chairperson of the Commission. Effective July 1, 2050. (HD1)

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
