A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HAWAIIAN HOME LANDS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 202, Hawaiian Homes Commission Act,
- 2 1920, as amended, is amended to read as follows:
- 4 compensation. (a) There shall be a department of Hawaiian home
- 5 lands which shall be headed by an executive board to be known as
- 6 the Hawaiian homes commission. The members of the commission
- 7 shall be nominated and appointed in accordance with section
- 8 26-34, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The commission shall be
- 9 composed of nine members, as follows: three shall be residents
- 10 of the city and county of Honolulu; two shall be residents of
- 11 the county of Hawaii one of whom shall be a resident of east
- 12 Hawaii and the other a resident of west Hawaii; two shall be
- 13 residents of the county of Maui one of whom shall be a resident
- 14 from the island of Molokai; one shall be a resident of the
- 15 county of Kauai; and the ninth member shall be [the chairman] an
- 16 at-large member of the Hawaiian homes commission. All members
- 17 shall have been residents of the State at least three years

[prior to] before their appointment [and at]. At least [four] 1 2 five of the members shall be [descendants of not less than one-3 fourth part of the blood of the races inhabiting the] native 4 Hawaiian [Islands previous to 1778.] and either existing or prospective lessees of Hawaiian homestead lands; provided that 5 6 at least two of these five members shall be on the department of 7 Hawaiian home lands waitlist for a homestead land award for housing, farming, or ranching; provided further that if any 8 9 commission member who became a member based on the member's 10 status as a lessee or presence on the waitlist subsequently 11 ceases to be a lessee or is removed from the waitlist during the **12** member's term, the member may continue to serve on the 13 commission until that member's term expires. The members of the 14 commission shall serve without pay, but shall receive actual 15 expenses incurred by them in the discharge of their duties as 16 [such] commission members. The [governor] commission members **17** shall [appoint the chairman] elect a chairperson and vice 18 chairperson of the commission from among the commission members 19 [thereof]. **20** [The commission may delegate to the chairman such] The 21 governor shall nominate and, with the advice and consent of the

The director of Hawaiian home lands 3 shall exercise the duties, powers, and authority or so much 4 thereof, delegated to the director by the commission, and as may 5 be lawful or proper for the [performance of the functions vested 6 in the commission.] administration of the department. [He shall, in such 9 capacity, perform such duties, and exercise such powers and 10 authority, or so much thereof, as may be delegated to him by the 11 commission as herein provided above.] 12 The provisions of section 76-16, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall apply to the positions of [first] deputy 13 14 director and private secretary to the [chairman of the 15 commission.] director. - 14 SECTION 2. Section 222, Hawaiian Homes Commission Act,
- 15 1920, as amended, is amended by amending subsection (a) to read
- 16 as follows:
- 17 "(a) The department may make [such] expenditures and shall
- 18 adopt rules in accordance with chapter 91, Hawaii Revised
- 19 Statutes, as are necessary for the efficient execution of the
- 20 functions vested in the department by this Act. All
- 21 expenditures of the department and all moneys necessary for

- 1 loans made by the department, in accordance with [the provisions
- 2 of this Act, shall be allowed and paid upon the presentation of
- 3 itemized vouchers approved by the [chairman] chairperson of the
- 4 commission or the [chairman's] chairperson's designated
- 5 representative. The department shall make an annual report to
- 6 the legislature of the State upon the first day of each regular
- 7 session and [such] any special reports as the legislature may
- 8 from time to time require. The [chairman] chairperson and
- 9 members of the commission shall give bond as required by law.
- 10 The sureties upon the bond and the conditions thereof shall be
- 11 approved annually by the governor."
- 12 SECTION 3. Section 26-17, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 13 amended to read as follows:
- 14 "§26-17 Department of Hawaiian home lands. The department
- 15 of Hawaiian home lands shall be headed by an executive board to
- 16 be known as the Hawaiian homes commission.
- 17 The commission shall be composed of nine members. The
- 18 appointment, tenure, and removal of the members and the filling
- 19 of vacancies on the commission shall be in accordance with
- 20 section 26-34 and section 202(a) of the Hawaiian Homes
- 21 Commission Act of 1920, as amended. The [governor] commission

1 members shall [appoint the] elect a chairperson and vice 2 chairperson of the commission from among the commission members 3 [thereof]. 4 [The commission may delegate to the chairperson such] The 5 governor shall nominate and, with the advice and consent of the 6 senate, appoint a director of Hawaiian home lands who is not a 7 member of the commission. The director of Hawaiian home lands shall exercise the duties, powers, and authority, or so much 8 9 thereof, delegated to the director by the commission, and as may **10** be lawful or proper[7] for the [performance of the functions 11 vested in the commission.] administration of the department. 12 The [chairperson of the board] director of Hawaiian home 13 lands shall serve in a full-time capacity [and shall perform 14 such duties, and exercise such powers and authority, or so much 15 thereof as may be delegated to the chairperson by the board]. 16 The department shall administer the Hawaiian Homes Commission Act of 1920 as set forth in the Constitution of the 17 18 State and by law. 19 The functions and authority heretofore exercised by the 20 Hawaiian homes commission as heretofore constituted are

- 1 transferred to the department of Hawaiian home lands established
- 2 by this chapter."
- 3 SECTION 4. Any sitting Hawaiian homes commission member
- 4 whose term of office has not expired as of the effective date of
- 5 this Act and who does not qualify to be a member of the Hawaiian
- 6 homes commission under the amendments made by this Act may
- 7 continue to serve on the commission until that member's term
- 8 expires.
- 9 SECTION 5. The incumbent who occupies the position of
- 10 chairperson of the Hawaiian homes commission on the effective
- 11 date of this Act shall continue to serve in that capacity with
- 12 all the powers and duties appertaining thereto prior to the
- 13 effective date of this Act until a director of Hawaiian home
- 14 lands is nominated and, subject to the advice and consent of the
- 15 senate, appointed pursuant to section 26-17, Hawaii Revised
- 16 Statutes. Beginning on the day the director of Hawaiian homes
- 17 lands is so appointed, the chairperson shall no longer receive a
- 18 salary and the director shall receive the salary formerly
- 19 assigned to the chairperson.
- 20 SECTION 6. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 21 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

1 SECTION 7. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

Report Title:

Department of Hawaiian Home Lands; HHC; Chairperson; Director

Description:

Requires at least 5 Hawaiian Homes Commission members to be Native Hawaiian or current Hawaiian homestead lessees; and at least 2 of those 5 to be on the waitlist for Hawaiian home lands. Authorizes commission members to elect a chairperson and vice chairperson. Creates the position of Director of Hawaiian Home Lands and separates the Director's responsibilities from those of the Chairperson of the Commission. Effective July 1, 2050. (HD2)
