#### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STADIUM AUTHORITY.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 109-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows: 3 "(a) There shall be within the department of accounting 4 and general services for administrative purposes only, a stadium 5 authority whose responsibility shall be to maintain, operate, 6 and manage the stadium and facilities attached thereto. The 7 authority shall consist of [nine] eleven members who shall be 8 appointed by the governor in the manner prescribed by section 9 26-34. 10 Of the eleven members, one member shall be a resident of 11 one of the areas specified in paragraph (1), (2), or (3) and one 12 member shall be a resident of the area specified in paragraph 13 (4):14 Excluding Ford Island, the area beginning at the (1) 15 intersection of Oahu shoreline and Admiral Carey (Ford

No person shall be appointed consecutively to more than two
terms as a member of the authority. Vacancies shall be filled
for the remainder of any unexpired term in the same manner as
original appointments."

5 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed6 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
