A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AFFORDABLE HOUSING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes that Hawaii is experiencing a severe affordable housing crisis with a lack of 2 3 affordable rental and for-sale units. According to the 2018 affordable rental housing report and ten-year plan, Hawaii will 4 need an additional 64,693 housing units by 2025 with nearly 5 6 seventy per cent of those units for low-income households 7 earning eighty per cent or less of the area median income. In 2016, the legislature established the goal of developing 8 22,500 affordable rental units by the end of 2026. Achieving 9 10 this goal will require a variety of approaches, including 11 continuing financial programs to promote the construction of low-income housing. One example is the low-income housing tax 12 13 credit program, a temporary program that provides a financing 14 incentive for private developers and nonprofit entities to 15 construct or rehabilitate affordable rental units. As part of the program, the Hawaii housing finance and development **16**

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- 1 corporation awards state and federal tax credits to encourage
- 2 the development and construction of affordable housing.
- 3 The purpose of this Act is to extend the temporary low-
- 4 income housing tax credit program for another six years to
- 5 December 31, 2027.
- 6 SECTION 2. Act 129, Session Laws of Hawaii 2016, is
- 7 amended by amending section 4 to read as follows:
- 8 "SECTION 4. This Act, upon its approval, shall take effect
- 9 on January 1, 2017, and shall apply to qualified low-income
- 10 buildings awarded credits after December 31, 2016; provided that
- 11 this Act shall be repealed on December 31, [2021,] 2027, and
- 12 section 235-110.8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, shall be reenacted
- 13 in the form in which it read on the day prior to the effective
- 14 date of this Act."
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2025, and
- 18 shall apply to taxable years beginning after December 31, 2020.
