### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO INVASIVE SPECIES.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that responding quickly
- 2 to newly detected invasive species often prevents the species
- 3 from becoming firmly established, thus saving taxpayers money in
- 4 the long term. State agencies currently lack the resources and
- 5 response mechanisms to deal with newly identified threats from
- 6 invasive species and may be missing opportunities to eliminate
- 7 them. Delays may allow invasive species to become established
- 8 in the State, and consequently, may make mitigation efforts more
- 9 protracted and expensive.
- 10 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to create a paid
- 11 response mechanism for invasive species so that newly detected
- 12 threats may be immediately addressed.
- 13 SECTION 2. Chapter 194, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 14 amended by adding a new section to be appropriately designated
- 15 and to read as follows:
- 16 "§194- Invasive species rapid response special fund.
- 17 (a) There is established the invasive species rapid response

- 1 special fund, into which shall be deposited appropriations by
- 2 the legislature for the purposes of mitigating or eradicating
- 3 newly detected invasive species threats in the State. All
- 4 interest earned or accrued on money deposited into the fund
- 5 shall become part of the fund. The council shall administer the
- 6 special fund and may expend money from the special fund in
- 7 accordance with this section.
- 8 (b) If the council determines that one or more newly
- 9 detected invasive species poses a substantial threat to the
- 10 agriculture, commerce, economy, environment, or public health of
- 11 the State or otherwise warrants immediate action, the council
- 12 shall submit a request to the governor to declare that there
- 13 exists an invasive species emergency.
- 14 (c) Upon declaration by the governor pursuant to
- 15 subsection (b) that an invasive species emergency exists, the
- 16 council may act in response to the emergency and may make
- 17 expenditures from the fund without legislative approval and
- 18 without regard to chapters 36, 37, 89, and 103D.
- 19 (d) The council shall make an account of money expended
- 20 from the fund and include that information in its annual report
- 21 to the legislature."

- 1 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 2 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 3 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 4 deposit into the invasive species rapid response special fund.
- 5 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 6 land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 4. New statutory material is underscored.
- 8 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
