### MAKING EMERGENCY APPROPRIATIONS FOR PUBLIC EMPLOYMENT COST ITEMS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

Salary increases and cost adjustments provided 17 in this Act for any officer or employee whose compensation is 18 paid, in whole or in part, from federal, special, or other funds 19 shall be paid wholly or proportionately, as the case may be, 20 from the respective funds.

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1	SECTION 11. Funds appropriated or authorized by this Act
2	that are not expended or encumbered by June 30, 2021, shall
3	lapse as of that date.

4 SECTION 12. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.





### Report Title:

Emergency Appropriations; Public Employment Cost Items; Bargaining Unit (2)

#### Description:

Makes emergency appropriations for fiscal biennium 2019-2021 for collective bargaining cost items, including the cost of salary adjustments negotiated between the State and the bargaining representative, for collective bargaining unit (2) and their excluded counterparts. Effective upon approval. (SD1)

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
