TITLE:

PURPOSE:

To make emergency appropriations for collective bargaining cost items and other public employment costs for the members of Unit (3) and their excluded counterparts, including the cost of salary adjustments negotiated between the State and the bargaining unit representative, for fiscal

biennium 2019-2021.

MEANS:

By the submittal of a specific appropriation

measure.

JUSTIFICATION:

Appropriations by the Legislature are necessary to cover the expected cost of implementing the collective bargaining agreement negotiated between the State and the respective bargaining unit representing state public officers and employees for the fiscal biennium that commenced July 1, 2019.

Inasmuch as an agreement with the bargaining unit was not reached in time to include all cost items in the 2019-2021 biennium budget, a separate measure is proposed for submittal to the Legislature.

The general fund appropriation included in this measure has been proposed with consideration of the statutorily defined appropriation ceiling for the Executive Branch pursuant to section 37-92, Hawaii Revised Statutes. The total proposed appropriations from the general fund (which include the Executive Supplemental Budget for fiscal biennium 2019-2021 and administration proposal BUF-08(20), appropriation for bargaining unit 13 collective bargaining increases to be

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submitted) exceed the appropriation ceiling by \$14,179,623 or 0.2 percent in fiscal year 2019-2020. Funding requested in this measure for collective bargaining increases for bargaining unit 3 will result in the appropriation ceiling for the Executive Branch to now be exceeded in fiscal year 2019-2020 by an additional \$29,686,820 or 0.4 percent. This current declaration takes into account additional general fund appropriations authorized for fiscal year 2019-2020 in the Executive Supplemental Budget, administration proposal BUF-08(20), and this measure only and does not include other general fund appropriations for fiscal year 2019-2020 that may be authorized for the Executive Branch in other legislation submitted to the Legislature during the regular session of 2020.

The total proposed appropriations from the general fund (which include the Executive Supplemental Budget for fiscal biennium 2019-2021 and administration proposal BUF-08(20), appropriation for bargaining unit 13 collective bargaining increases to be submitted) exceed the appropriation ceiling by \$24,761,740 or 0.3 percent in fiscal year 2020-2021. Funding requested in this measure for collective bargaining increases for bargaining unit 3 will result in the appropriation ceiling for the Executive Branch to now be exceeded in fiscal year 2020-2021 by an additional \$27,931,099 or 0.3 percent. This current declaration takes into account additional general fund appropriations authorized for fiscal year 2020-2021 in the Executive Supplemental Budget, administration proposal BUF-08(20), and this measure only and does not include other general fund appropriations for fiscal year 2020-2021 that may be authorized for the Executive Branch in other legislation



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submitted to the Legislature during the regular session of 2020.

Impact on the public: "(I)t is the public policy of the State to promote harmonious and cooperative relations between government and its employees and to protect the public by assuring effective and orderly operations of government. These policies are best effectuated by (1) recognizing the right of public employees to organize for the purpose of collective bargaining, (2) requiring the public employers to negotiate with and enter into written agreements with exclusive representatives on matters of wages, hours, and other conditions of employment, while, at the same time, (3) maintaining merit principles and the principle of equal pay for equal work among state and county employees " (Section 89-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes).

Impact on the department and other agencies: Pay raise and other negotiated cost items are not included in the departments' operating budget request.
