### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO STATE HOLIDAYS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 78, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended
- 2 by adding a new section to be appropriately designated and to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 "§78- Paid leave. (a) Employees shall be eligible for
- 5 up to eight hours of paid leave every even-numbered year during
- 6 normal business hours on a day previously agreed upon with their
- 7 employer; provided that the time off shall not be credited
- 8 against vacation or sick leave benefits if any; provided further
- 9 that the provision of paid leave shall not adversely interfere
- 10 with the operations of the work unit nor require the applicable
- 11 agency to incur costs for additional human resources or
- 12 overtime.
- (b) Employees shall take no more than eight hours of paid
- 14 leave under this section during any two calendar year period."
- 15 SECTION 2. Section 8-1, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

1 SECTION 3. If any provision of this Act, or the 2 application thereof to any person or circumstance, is held 3 invalid, the entire Act shall be invalidated, and the Act shall 4 not be given effect, and to this end the provisions of this Act 5 are non-severable. 6 SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that 7 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were 8 begun before its effective date. 9 SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 10 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 11 SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
