5 (b) The director of commerce and consumer affairs or the6 director's designee shall chair the task force.

(c) The purpose of the task force is to develop proposed
legislation for the regulation of peer-to-peer motor vehicle
sharing companies and to identify any potential issues currently
unaddressed by state law. The task force shall submit a report
of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed
legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
to the convening of the regular session of 2020.

14 (d) The task force shall serve until it has accomplished
15 the purpose of this Act or twenty days prior to the convening of
16 the regular session of 2020, whichever occurs first.
