A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DEMENTIA TRAINING.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that as part of 2 addressing the present and continuing "silver tsunami" in 3 Hawaii, first responders should be adequately trained to 4 identify and interact appropriately with individuals with 5 Alzheimer's disease and related dementias. Because individuals 6 with Alzheimer's disease and related dementias may not respond 7 in a manner typically anticipated by first responders, providing 8 dementia training designed to help identify, interact with, and 9 intervene in cases of suspected abuse or neglect of individuals 10 with Alzheimer's disease and related dementias will enable these employees to better carry out their duties and responsibilities. 11

12 The purpose of this Act is to develop and provide dementia13 training to first responders.

SECTION 2. Chapter 321, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is amended by adding a new section to part XVIII to be appropriately designated and to read as follows:
