A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL DISTRICT BUILDINGS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) There is established the child care at
- 2 capital district buildings pilot project. The department of
- 3 human services shall establish child care facilities at any
- 4 capital district building, except Honolulu Hale, with an
- 5 emphasis on establishing facilities at the state capitol.
- 6 Enrollment priority shall be for children of state employees who
- 7 work in the building at which each child care facility is
- 8 located.
- 9 (b) The department of human services may contract with a
- 10 private entity to establish and run any child care facility of
- 11 the pilot project.
- 12 (c) The pilot project shall cease to exist on June 30,
- **13** 2023.
- (d) For the purposes of this Act, "child care facility"
- 15 shall have the same meaning as in section 346-151, Hawaii
- 16 Revised Statutes.

- 1 SECTION 2. The department of human services shall submit a
- 2 report to the legislature no later than twenty days prior to the
- 3 regular sessions of 2021, 2022, and 2023, on the pilot project,
- 4 including the progress of establishing the child care
- 5 facilities, the number of children enrolled, and proposed
- 6 legislation, if any.
- 7 SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general
- 8 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
- 9 much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 10 the child care at capital district buildings pilot project.
- 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 12 human services for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on December 31,
- 14 2059, and shall be repealed on June 30, 2023.
