A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TOURISM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The department of business, economic
- 2 development, and tourism shall study the need for a tourism
- 3 information center in the state capital district. The study
- 4 shall include an estimate of the number of tourists who visit
- 5 the state capitol building annually.
- 6 (b) The department of business, economic development, and
- 7 tourism shall report its findings and recommendations, including
- 8 any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than
- 9 twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
- 10 2021.
- 11 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 12 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 13 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for a
- 14 study to determine whether a tourism information center is
- 15 needed in the state capital district.

- 1 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 2 business, economic development, and tourism for the purposes of
- 3 this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
