A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TOURISM.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. (a) The Hawaii tourism authority shall study
- 2 the need for a tourism information center in the state capital
- 3 district. The study shall include an estimate of the number of
- 4 tourists who visit the state capital district annually, visitor
- 5 services provided, and visitor needs.
- 6 (b) The Hawaii tourism authority shall report its findings
- 7 and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the
- 8 legislature no later than twenty days prior to the convening of
- 9 the regular session of 2021.
- 10 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 11 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 12 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for a
- 13 study to determine whether a tourism information center is
- 14 needed in the state capital district.
- The sum appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
- 16 tourism authority for the purposes of this Act.
- 17 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2099.
