

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO BALLOONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 339, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new part to be appropriately designated and
- 3 to read as follows:
- 4 "PART . RELEASE OF BALLOONS
- 5 §339- Prohibited acts. No person shall release,
- 6 outdoors, balloons made of electrically conductive material and
- 7 filled with a gas lighter than air, as part of any public or
- 8 civic event, promotional activity, or product advertisement.
- 9 §339- Penalties. (a) Any person who violates this
- 10 part shall be subject to a fine of \$250.
- 11 (b) Any person who violates this part who has been
- 12 previously convicted at least twice of violating this part shall
- 13 be guilty of a misdemeanor.
- (c) This part shall not apply to manned hot air balloons
- 15 or to balloons used in governmental or scientific research
- 16 projects.

- 1 §339- Rules. The department shall adopt rules pursuant
- 2 to chapter 91 necessary to implement this part."
- 3 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 4 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 5 begun before its effective date.
- 6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
