A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 323F-3, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsections (a) and (b) to read as follows:
3	"(a)	The corporation shall be governed by [an eighteen
4	member] <u>a</u>	nineteen-member board of directors that shall carry
5	out the d	uties and responsibilities of the corporation other
6	than thos	e duties and responsibilities relating to the
7	establish	ment of any captive insurance company pursuant to
8	section 3	23F-7(c)(20) and the operation thereof.
9	(b)	The members of the corporation board shall be
10	appointed	as follows:
11	(1)	The director of health as an ex officio, voting
12		member;
13	(2)	The five regional chief executive officers as ex
14		officio, nonvoting members;
15	(3)	[Three] Two members who reside in the county of Maui,
16		[two] <u>one</u> of whom shall be appointed by the Maui
17		regional system board and one of whom shall be

1		appointed by the governor, all of whom shall serve as
2		voting members;
3	(4)	Two members who reside in the eastern section of the
4		county of Hawaii, one of whom shall be appointed by
5		the East Hawaii regional system board and one of whom
6		shall be appointed by the governor, both of whom shall
7		serve as voting members;
8	(5)	Two members who reside in the western section of the
9		county of Hawaii, one of whom shall be appointed by
10		the West Hawaii regional system board and one of whom
11		shall be appointed by the governor, both of whom shall
12		serve as voting members;
13	(6)	Two members who reside on the island of Kauai, one of
14		whom shall be appointed by the Kauai regional system
15		board and one of whom shall be appointed by the
16		governor, both of whom shall serve as voting members;
17	(7)	Two members who reside on the island of Oahu, one of
18		whom shall be appointed by the Oahu regional system
19		board and one of whom shall be appointed by the
20		governor, both of whom shall serve as voting members;
21		and

1	(8) [One member] Inree members who shall be appointed by
2	the governor and serve as [an] at-large voting
3	[member.] members.
4	The appointed board members who reside in the county of
5	Maui, eastern section of the county of Hawaii, western section
6	of the county of Hawaii, on the island of Kauai, and on the
7	island of Oahu shall each serve for a term of four years;
8	provided that the terms of the initial appointments of the
9	members who are appointed by their respective regional system
10	boards shall be as follows: one of the initial members from the
11	county of Maui shall be appointed to serve a term of two years
12	and the other member shall be appointed to serve a term of four
13	years; the initial member from East Hawaii shall be appointed to
14	serve a term of two years; the initial member from West Hawaii
15	shall be appointed to serve a term of four years; the initial
16	member from the island of Kauai shall be appointed to serve a
17	term of two years; and the initial member from the island of
18	Oahu shall be appointed to serve a term of four years; and
19	provided further that the terms of the initial appointments of
20	the members who are appointed by the governor shall be four

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- 1 years. The at-large member appointed by the governor shall
- 2 serve a term of two years.
- 3 Any vacancy shall be filled in the same manner provided for
- 4 the original appointments. The corporation board shall elect
- 5 its own chair from among its members. Appointments to the
- 6 corporation board shall be as representative as possible of the
- 7 system's stakeholders as outlined in this subsection. The board
- 8 member appointments shall strive to create a board that includes
- 9 expertise in the fields of medicine, finance, health care
- 10 administration, government affairs, human resources, and law."
- 11 SECTION 2. The term of the board member affected by this
- 12 Act shall expire on the effective date of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 14 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 15 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
