

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO ELECTRIC VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Act 168, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, as 2 amended by Act 143, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, is amended as 3 follows: 4 1. By amending section 2, subsection (b) to read: 5 "(b) An electric vehicle on which an electric vehicle license plate is affixed shall be exempt from payment of parking 6 7 fees, including those collected through parking meters, charged 8 by any state or county authority in this State[, except]; 9 provided that [this exemption shall not apply]: 10 For [more than] metered parking stalls, this exemption (1)11 shall be limited to two and one-half hours [of metered parking], or the maximum amount of time the meter 12 13 allows, whichever is longer; [or] 14 [To] This exemption shall not apply to parking fees (2) 15 assessed in increments longer than one twenty-four-16 hour day, including weekly, monthly, or annual parking 17 permits[-]; and

1	(3)	For parking at airports, this exemption shall be
2		limited to drivers who are parking at the airport as
3		an airline passenger, as evidenced by a valid airline
4		ticket or boarding pass bearing the name of the
5		driver, which shall be presented to the applicable
6		parking attendant; provided further that this
7		exemption shall not apply to drivers who are parking
8		at the airport while carrying out the driver's duties
9		and responsibilities as an employee of the airport."
10	2.	By amending section 4 to read:
11	"SEC	TION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval
12	and shall	be repealed on June 30, [2020.] <u>2028.</u> "

Report Title:

Electric Vehicles; Parking Fees; Airports; Airline Passengers; Sunset Date

Description:

Limits the electric vehicle parking fee exemption at airports to drivers of electric vehicles who are airline passengers, as evidenced by a valid airline ticket or boarding pass. Extends the repeal date of Act 168, Session Laws of Hawaii 2012, from 6/30/2020 to 6/30/2028.
