BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 128D-7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows: 3 "(b) The department shall adopt, by rules, the criteria for the selection and for the priority ranking of sites pursuant 4 5 to subsection (c) for removal and remedial action under this chapter, and shall adopt criteria for the ranking of sites in 6 7 order of priority. The criteria shall take into account the 8 pertinent factors relating to the public health and the environment, which shall include, but are not limited to, 9 10 potential hazards to public health and the environment, the risk 11 of fire or explosion, toxic hazards, the extent to which the 12 deferral of remedial action will result, or is likely to result, 13 in a rapid increase in cost or in a hazard to human health and 14 the environment. The criteria may include a minimum hazard 15 threshold below which sites shall not be listed pursuant to this 16 section[-]; provided that any minimum hazard threshold levels, 17 including any environmental cleanup levels, developed by the
