A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF THE ATTORNEY GENERAL.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the existence of 2 organized crime is a contributing factor to the recent wave of 3 property and violent crimes on Oahu. Law enforcement agencies 4 need better tools to identify, investigate, arrest, and prosecute members of organized crime groups. The legislature 5 6 also finds that the department of the attorney general has an 7 organized crime unit that exists in name, but no actual staff 8 with which to operate the unit. The purpose of the unit is to 9 develop tactical and strategic intelligence, assist in 10 controlling the spread of organized crime activity, and provide 11 technical assistance to county law enforcement agencies in the 12 detection and prosecution of organized crime activities.

13 The purpose of this Act is to provide funding for needed 14 positions to operate the department of the attorney general's 15 organized crime unit.

16 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
17 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so.




