A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAIIAN HOMES COMMISSION ACT.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that while basic
- 2 department of Hawaiian home lands applicant waiting lists are
- 3 available for download on the department's website, the exact
- 4 details of each applicant, including whether the person has
- 5 applied for multiple leases, been denied a prior lease, or been
- 6 skipped over, is not readily accessible, even for department
- 7 staff. Beneficiary records of the department of Hawaiian home
- 8 lands are spread across multiple locations. If a beneficiary
- 9 seeks to determine his or her status, finding and gathering that
- 10 information can take weeks. This lack of organization has led
- 11 to some lessees abusing the program by selling or transferring
- 12 their leases and reapplying for a subsequent lease.
- 13 The legislature further finds that compiling applicant
- 14 information into a single database will help increase the
- 15 efficiency of the department of Hawaiian home lands and reduce
- 16 lease award abuse by lessees.

- 1 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 2 Hawaiian home lands to digitize its beneficiary waiting lists
- 3 and other related data.
- 4 SECTION 2. The department of Hawaiian home lands, with the
- 5 assistance of the office of enterprise technology services,
- 6 shall create a digital database of its applicant, beneficiary,
- 7 and lessee records. The database shall contain relevant
- 8 information on each individual's homestead lease application
- 9 status, number of applications, address, number of denied
- 10 leases, designated successors, history of whether the individual
- 11 obtained a lease as an applicant or as a successor, and other
- 12 information as determined by the Hawaiian homes commission.
- 13 The digital database required by this Act shall be
- 14 completed and available for use by the department of Hawaiian
- 15 home lands no later than July 1, 2020.
- 16 SECTION 3. The department of Hawaiian home lands shall use
- 17 funds from its operating budget, program ID HHL625, in addition
- 18 to funds appropriated in this Act, to create the digital
- 19 database required by this Act.
- 20 SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
- 21 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much

- 1 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the
- 2 same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
- 3 2020-2021 for the department of Hawaiian home lands to create a
- 4 digital database pursuant to this Act.
- 5 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department
- 6 of Hawaiian home lands for the purposes of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
