SECTION 1. Section 286-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

RELATING TO MOTOR VEHICLE REGISTRATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

All 13 applications shall also contain a description of the vehicle,

including the name of the maker, the type of fuel for the use of

petroleum gas), the serial or motor number, and the date first

sold by the manufacturer or dealer, and such further description

which it is adapted (e.g., gasoline, diesel oil, liquefied

- 4 registration of a neighborhood electric vehicle shall certify in
- 5 writing that a notice of the operational restrictions applying

- 9 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
