### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 PART I. GENERAL PROVISIONS 2 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE. This Act shall be known and may be cited as the Supplemental Improvements Act of 2020. 3 4 SECTION 2. This part amends Act 40, Session Laws of Hawaii 5 2019, and other appropriations and authorizations effective 6 during fiscal biennium 2019-2021. 7 SECTION 3. Part II of Act 40, Session Laws of Hawaii 2019, 8 is amended by amending section 3 to read as follows: "SECTION 3. APPROPRIATIONS. The following sums, or so 9 much thereof as may be sufficient to accomplish the purposes and 10 programs designated herein, are hereby appropriated or 11 12 authorized, as the case may be, from the means of financing specified to the expending agencies designated for the fiscal 13 14 biennium beginning July 1, 2019, and ending June 30, 2021. 15 total expenditures and the number of positions in each fiscal

year of the biennium shall not exceed the sums and the position

Accounting of the appropriations by the department of accounting and general services shall be based on the projects 7 8 as the projects are listed in this section. Several related or similar projects may be combined into a single project if the 9 10 combination is advantageous or convenient for implementation; 11 provided that the total cost of the projects thus combined shall 12 not exceed the total of the sum specified for the projects 13 separately. (The amount after each cost element and the total 14 funding for each project listed in this part are in thousands of 15 dollars).

- 17 mechanical errors are found in this Act, the governor is hereby
- 18 authorized to correct the errors.

1 SECTION 10. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2020.
