A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE KA IWI COAST.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the lands of the Ka
- 2 Iwi coast are an invaluable natural asset for the people of
- 3 Hawaii. Numerous community members and organizations have
- 4 fought long and hard over many decades to protect and preserve
- 5 this unspoiled area for future generations.
- 6 The legislature further finds that a growing interest in
- 7 this area of Oahu has brought a rapid increase in visitors to
- 8 the Ka Iwi coast, and without proper management the area will
- 9 inevitably become overrun by invasive species and commercial
- 10 interests or become subject to future development.
- 11 Collaboration between community organizations and
- 12 government agencies is necessary to address myriad issues, such
- 13 as managing human impacts, preventing invasive species, and
- 14 restoring the Wawamalu dune system.
- 15 The purpose of this Act is to protect and preserve the
- 16 lands of the Ka Iwi coast in perpetuity by establishing the Ka

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- 1 Iwi coast state park for the benefit of local residents and
- 2 future generations.
- 3 SECTION 2. (a) Lands spanning Wawamalu to Makapuu,
- 4 identified by tax map key numbers: a portion of 1-3-9-10-3; a
- 5 portion of 1-3-9-12-2; 1-3-9-10-2; 1-3-9-15-20; 1-3-9-15-19; and
- 6 a portion of 1-3-9-15-1, shall be transferred to the department
- 7 of land and natural resources. These lands, and those adjacent
- 8 to it that are owned by the State of Hawaii, are designated as a
- 9 state park under the name "Ka Iwi coast state park", to be
- 10 administered by the department of land and natural resources.
- 11 (b) All land within the Ka Iwi coast state park shall be
- 12 designated conservation land. Any land of differing designation
- 13 shall have its designation automatically changed to
- 14 conservation.
- 15 (c) Land in the Ka Iwi coast state park shall, in
- 16 perpetuity, be preserved primarily in its wild and natural
- 17 state.
- 18 (d) Any land subsequently added to the Ka Iwi coast state
- 19 park shall be subject to the provisions established in this
- 20 section.

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1	(e) This Act shall be exempt from the requirements of
2	section 171-64.7, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and the boundary
3	amendment requirements of chapter 205, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
4	SECTION 3. The following positions are established within
5	the department of land and natural resources:
6	(1) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) property managemen
7	position; and
8	(2) One full-time equivalent (1.0 FTE) interpretive
9	specialist.
10	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
11	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so
12	much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
13	the planning and establishment of the Ka Iwi coast state park;
14	provided that the planning and establishment shall:
15	(1) Build upon and reflect the direction of recent work
16	for the Maunalua-Makapuu scenic byway and Ka Iwi coas
17	master plans; and
18	(2) Include stakeholders who helped create the Maunalua-
19	Makapuu scenic byway and Ka Iwi coast master plans as
20	well as others in the local community who are

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1	dedicated to the preservation of the lands of the Ka
2	Iwi coast.
3	The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
4	land and natural resources for the purposes of this Act.
5	SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
