A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 291C, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part IV to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§291C- Flood zone; depth gauge signs. (a) The
- 5 department of transportation or appropriate county agency shall
- 6 post a depth gauge sign on any portion of a public highway that:
- 7 (1) Is under its jurisdiction;
- 8 (2) Lies within a special flood hazard area; and
- 9 (3) Is prone to flooding.
- (b) The depth gauge sign shall be posted in a manner
- 11 consistent with the Federal Highway Administration's Manual on
- 12 Uniform Traffic Control Devices, as amended.
- (c) As used in this section:
- "Depth gauge sign" means a depth gauge or flood gauge sign
- 15 in conformity with the Federal Highway Administration's Manual
- 16 on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, as amended.

- 1 "Public highway" shall have the same meaning as in section
- **2** 264-1.
- 3 "Special flood hazard area" means an area identified as a
- 4 special flood hazard area by the Federal Emergency Management
- 5 Agency."
- 6 SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general
- 7 revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
- 8 thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 for
- 9 posting of depth gauge signs on public highways pursuant to this
- 10 Act.
- 11 The sum appropriated shall be expended by the department of
- 12 transportation for the purposes of this Act.
- 13 SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
- 14 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
