A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO DERELICT VEHICLES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 290-8, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 1 amended to read as follows: 2 3 "\$290-8 Derelict vehicle. A vehicle shall be deemed a 4 derelict vehicle by the administrative head of the county agency 5 designated to carry out section 290-1, or by the executive 6 director or a representative of the executive director of the 7 Hawaii public housing authority in the case of a vehicle that has been abandoned on property owned, managed, or administered 8 9 by the authority, if a part has been removed or material damage 10 to the vehicle has rendered the vehicle inoperable and one of 11 the following conditions exists: 12 The vehicle is registered for the current registration (1) 13 period and the registered and legal owners no longer 14 reside at the addresses on record with the county 15 director of finance; 16 The vehicle has been registered for the current or (2)

previous registration period and the registered and

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1		regar owners discraim ownership, or a motice or
2		transfer has been submitted by the registered and
3		legal owners and recorded with the director of finance
4		and the new owner has not transferred the title or
5		registration into the new owner's name within thirty
6		days of release;
7	(3)	The vehicle identification number and license plates
8		have been removed so as to nullify efforts to locate
9		or identify the current registered and legal owners;
10	(4)	The vehicle has not been registered for the previous
11		twelve month period; [ex]
12	(5)	The vehicle registration records of the county
13		director of finance contain no record that the vehicle
14		has ever been registered in the county[-]; or
15	(6)	The vehicle is valued at less than \$1,000.
16	Prior to	authorizing the removal of a derelict vehicle, the
17	administr	ative head of the county agency designated to carry out
18	section 2	90-1 or the executive director or a representative of
19	the execu	tive director of the Hawaii public housing authority in
20	the case	of vehicles that have been abandoned on property owned,
21	managed,	or operated by the authority, shall notify the county

- 1 chief of police only if the vehicle is reported stolen or
- 2 otherwise needed for police investigation."

- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 28, 2081.
