## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Section 286-26, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	y amending subsection (h) to read as follows:
3	"(h)	This section shall not apply to:
4	(1)	Any motor vehicle [which] that is covered by part XI,
5		governing safety of motor carrier vehicle operation
6		and equipment; provided that the rules adopted
7		pursuant to part IA impose standards of inspection at
8		least as strict as those imposed under subsection (g)
9		and that certification is required at least as often
10		as provided in subsections (a), (b), (c), and (d);
11	(2)	Aircraft servicing vehicles that are being used
12		exclusively on lands set aside to the department of
13		transportation for airport purposes; and
14	(3)	Tractor trucks, forklifts, and top picks being used as
15		marine terminal equipment temporarily moving in or
16		between terminals at:

1		(A) Sand Island and along Sand Island Parkway and
2		Sand Island Access Road[-];
3		(B) Kalanianaole Avenue between Kuhio Street and
4		Kahanu Street, abutting Hilo Harbor;
5		(C) Kawaihae-Mahukona Road abutting Kawaihae Harbor;
6		(D) East Kaahumanu Avenue between Hobron Avenue and
7		Kane Street abutting Kahului Harbor; and
8		(E) Waipaa Road abutting Nawiliwili Harbor."
9	SECT	ION 2. Section 286-41, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended by	y amending subsection (f) to read as follows:
11	"(f)	The provisions of this part requiring the
12	registrat:	ion of motor vehicles shall not apply to:
13	(1)	Special mobile equipment;
14	(2)	Implements of husbandry temporarily drawn, moved, or
15		otherwise propelled upon the public highways;
16	(3)	Aircraft servicing vehicles which are being used
17		exclusively on lands set aside to the department of
18		transportation for airport purposes; and
19	(4)	Tractor trucks, forklifts, and top picks being used as
20		marine terminal equipment temporarily moving in or
21		between terminals at:

1	(A)	Sand Island and along Sand Island Parkway and
2		Sand Island Access Road[-];
3	(B)	Kalanianaole Avenue between Kuhio Street and
4		Kahanu Street, abutting Hilo Harbor;
5	(C)	Kawaihae-Mahukona Road abutting Kawaihae Harbor;
6	(D)	East Kaahumanu Avenue between Hobron Avenue and
7		Kane Street abutting Kahului Harbor; and
8	<u>(E)</u>	Waipaa Road abutting Nawiliwili Harbor."
9	SECTION 3	. Section 286-105, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
10	amended to rea	d as follows:
11	"§286-105	What persons are exempt from license. The
12	following pers	ons are exempt from license:
13	(1) Any	person while driving or operating a motor vehicle
14	in t	he service or employ of any branch or agency of
15	the	federal government; provided that the person has
16	rece	ived a license or permit from the branch or agency
17	to o	perate and drive the motor vehicle; provided
18	furt	her that the branch or agency has been duly
19	auth	orized by the federal government to issue the
20	lice	nse or permit;

1	(2)	Any person while driving or operating any road
2		machine, farm tractor, or implement of husbandry
3		temporarily operated or moved on a highway, or tractor
4		trucks, forklifts, and top picks being used as marine
5		terminal equipment temporarily moving in or between
6		terminals at Sand Island and along Sand Island Parkway
7		and Sand Island Access Road; provided that no person
8		under the age of thirteen years shall be permitted to
9		drive or operate any such road machine, farm tractor,
10		implement of husbandry, on a highway, or tractor
11		trucks, forklifts, and top picks being used as marine
12		terminal equipment temporarily moving in or between
13		terminals at:
14		(A) Sand Island and along Sand Island Parkway and
15		Sand Island Access Road;
16		(B) Kalanianaole Avenue between Kuhio Street and
17		Kahanu Street, abutting Hilo Harbor;
18		(C) Kawaihae-Mahukona Road abutting Kawaihae Harbor;
19		(D) East Kaahumanu Avenue between Hobron Avenue and
20		Kane Street abutting Kahului Harbor; and
21		(E) Waipaa Road abutting Nawiliwili Harbor;

(3)	Any person who is at least eighteen years of age and
	who has in the person's possession a valid driver's
	license to drive the categories of motor vehicles
	listed in section 286-102(b), except section 286-
	102(b)(4), that is equivalent to a driver's license
	issued in this State but was issued to the person in
	another state of the United States, the Commonwealth
	of Puerto Rico, United States Virgin Islands, American
	Samoa, Guam, a province of the Dominion of Canada, or
	the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands for
	that category of motor vehicle [which] that the person
	is operating;

- (4) Any person who has in the person's possession a valid commercial motor vehicle driver's license issued by any state of the United States, Mexico, or a province of the Dominion of Canada that issues licenses in accordance with the minimum federal standards for the issuance of commercial motor vehicle driver's licenses; and
- (5) Any person who drives or operates state or county motor vehicles while employed by, in the service of,

1	or volunteering for the state or county fire
2	departments, provided that they are trained and
3	certified to drive category (4) motor vehicles as set
4	forth in section 286-102(b)(4) by the state or county
5	government, as appropriate, and provided that the
6	person maintains a category (3) license as set forth
7	in section 286-102(b)(3)."
8	SECTION 4. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
9	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
10	begun before its effective date.
11	SECTION 5. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
12	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
13	SECTION 6. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
