BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 92-11, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 "§92-11 Voidability. Any final action taken in violation
- 4 of sections 92-3 and 92-7 may be voidable upon proof of
- 5 violation. A suit to void any final action shall be commenced
- 6 within [ninety] one hundred eighty days of the action."
- 7 SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
- 8 matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
- 9 begun before its effective date.
- 10 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 11 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 12 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on January 28, 2081.
