BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

2	SECTION 1. There is appropriated out of the general
3	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
4	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 to be
5	deposited into the research and development special fund
6	established pursuant to section 206M-15.3, Hawaii Revised
7	Statutes.
8	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the research and
9	development special fund the sum of \$ or so much thereof
10	as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 for the purposes
11	of the research and development program established pursuant to
12	206M-15.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes.
13	SECTION 3. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the
14	Hawaii technology development corporation for the purposes of
15	this Act.

2	SECTION 4. There is appropriated out of the general
3	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much
4	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 to be
5	deposited into the alternative energy research and development

7	SECTION 5. There is appropriated out of the alternative
8	energy research and development revolving fund the sum of
9	\$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year
10	2019-2020 for the purpose of providing grants pursuant to the
11	alternative energy research and development program.
12	SECTION 6. The sums appropriated shall be expended by the
13	Hawaii technology development corporation for the purposes of
14	this part.
