A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO WORKS OF ART SPECIAL FUND.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 103-8.5, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 2 amended as follows:

3 1. By amending subsection (a) to read:

4 "(a) There is created a works of art special fund, into 5 which shall be transferred [one] 0.5 per cent of all state fund 6 appropriations for capital improvements designated for the 7 construction cost element; provided that this transfer shall 8 apply only to capital improvement appropriations that are 9 designated for the construction [or renovation] of new state 10 buildings[+], properties, or facilities. The [one] 0.5 per cent 11 transfer requirement shall not apply to appropriations from the 12 passenger facility charge special fund established by section 13 261-5.5 and the rental motor vehicle customer facility charge 14 special fund established under section 261-5.6."

15 2. By amending subsection (c) to read:

16 "(c) The [one] 0.5 per cent amount, which is included in
17 all capital improvement appropriations [-] designated for the

1 construction of new state buildings, properties or facilities, 2 shall be calculated at the time the appropriation bills are 3 signed into law. The moneys shall be transferred into the works 4 of art special fund upon availability of moneys from the 5 appropriations. Each agency receiving capital improvement 6 appropriations shall calculate the [one] 0.5 per cent amount and 7 transfer the moneys into the works of art special fund." 8 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 9 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 10 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 11
