A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that community service is 2 an excellent way to train students for citizenship by engaging 3 them in active civic participation. Active participation of 4 young adults in service activities is necessary to achieve a 5 truly healthy community. Community service is a way to explore 6 careers and gain work skills. All students benefit from the 7 lessons learned through community service, and requiring 8 students to perform community service reaches those students who 9 may not otherwise participate. Community service offers 10 students: 11 Psychological and social development; (1)(2) 12 Intellectual and academic benefits; 13 Civic education: and (3) 14 (4)An opportunity to provide community benefits. 15 The purpose of this Act is to establish community service

as a graduation requirement for public high school students.
