A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO AQUATIC RESOURCES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SEC	FION 1. Chapter 187A, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended b	by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3	designate	ed and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§1</u> 8	Molokini user fees; special fund. (a) There
5	is estab	lished within the state treasury the Molokini special
6	fund, int	to which shall be deposited:
7	(1)	Appropriations by the legislature to the special fund;
8	(2)	All proceeds remitted to or collected by the
9		department derived from Molokini user fees; and
10	(3)	Civil, criminal, and administrative penalties, fines,
11		and other charges collected under this section or any
12		rule adopted pursuant to this section.
13	(b)	The department may require any commercial operator who
14	conducts	dive tours, charters, or other activities within the
15	Molokini	shoal to charge each customer of the commercial
16	operator	a user fee. The commercial operator shall remit the
17	revenues	derived from the collected user fees to the department;

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1	provided	that the commercial operator may retain \$1 of the fee	
2	as an adm	inistrative cost of collecting the fee. The department	
3	shall dep	osit the moneys from the fees collected into the	
4	Molokini special fund.		
5	(c)	Moneys in the Molokini special fund may be expended:	
6	(1)	For marine enforcement and monitoring, including	
7		positions for monitoring the Molokini shoal and	
8		related equipment and expenses;	
9	(2)	Inspection, maintenance, and construction of moorings	
10		and other improvements within the Molokini shoal; and	
11	(3)	Inspection, maintenance, and construction of moorings	
12		and other improvements along leeward Maui directly	
13		related to the support of commercial operators	
14		conducting activities within the Molokini shoal.	
15	<u>(d)</u>	The department shall adopt rules in accordance with	
16	chapter 91 to implement this section."		
17	SECT	ION 2. There is appropriated out of the general	
18	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$1,360,000 or so much		
19	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the		
20	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
21	2020-2021 for deposit into the Molokini special fund.		

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1	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the Molokini		
2	special f	and the sum of \$1,360,000 or so much thereof as may be	
3	necessary	for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the same sum or so much	
4	thereof a	s may be necessary for fiscal year 2020-2021 as	
5	follows:		
6	(1)	The sum of \$350,000 for three full-time equivalent	
7		(3.0 FTE) conservation and resources enforcement	
8		officers, a vessel, and related equipment;	
9	(2)	The sum of \$310,000 for five full-time equivalent (5.0	
10		FTE) positions to monitor commercial activities within	
11		the Molokini shoal;	
12	(3)	The sum of \$300,000 for inspection and maintenance of	
13		existing moorings within the Molokini shoal and along	
14		leeward Maui; and	
15	(4)	The sum of \$400,000 for new moorings along leeward	
16		Maui.	
17	The	sums appropriated shall be expended by the department	
18	of land a	nd natural for the purposes of this Act.	
19	SECT	ION 4. New statutory material is underscored.	

1 SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
