

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE STATE BUILDING CODE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the state building
- 2 code shall be based upon the building, residential, plumbing,
- 3 electrical, energy, and elevator codes. Pursuant to chapter
- 4 107, Hawaii Revised Statutes, the state building code is adopted
- 5 by the state building code council, which is made up of expert
- 6 members representing designers, contractors, industry
- 7 representatives, county building, fire, and other state
- 8 regulatory code officials. The state building code council is
- 9 administratively attached to the department of accounting and
- 10 general services. After the building codes are adopted by the
- 11 state building code council, the department of accounting and
- 12 general services is required to adopt administrative rules
- 13 pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised Statutes, to implement
- 14 the codes. The building codes are exempt from public hearings
- 15 pursuant to chapter 91, but are adopted pursuant to chapter 92,
- 16 Hawaii Revised Statutes, where stakeholders meet in an open
- 17 forum to discuss the various building codes. These state codes

- form a consistent basis for the adoption of building codes for 1
- the counties and for designers and contractors. 2
- The purpose of this Act is to repeal the requirement for 3
- the adoption of rules pursuant to chapter 91, Hawaii Revised 4
- Statutes, after the building codes are adopted by the state 5
- building code council, thereby requiring the state building code 6
- to be adopted pursuant only to chapter 92, Hawaii Revised 7
- Statutes, in conformance with all other state buildings codes. 8
- SECTION 2. Section 107-29, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is 9
- amended to read as follows: 10
- "[+]§107-29[+] Rules. The department [$\frac{1}{2}$] $\frac{1}{2}$ adopt 11
- rules pursuant to chapter 91 necessary for the purposes of this 12
- 13 part."
- SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed 14
- and stricken. New statutory material is underscored. 15
- SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval. 16
