

### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LIFEGUARDS.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Chapter 663, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
- 3 designated and to read as follows:
- 4 "§663- Exception to liability for county lifeguard
- 5 services. (a) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, a
- 6 county lifeguard, the employing county, or the State shall not
- 7 be liable for any civil damages resulting from any act or
- 8 omission of a lifeguard while the lifeguard is providing rescue,
- 9 resuscitation, or other lifeguard services on the beach or in
- 10 the ocean that are within the course and scope of the
- 11 lifeguard's employment as a county lifeguard; provided that this
- 12 exception to liability shall not apply when a claim for civil
- 13 damages results from a county lifeguard's gross negligence or
- 14 wanton act or omission.
- (b) As used in this section:
- "County lifeguard" means a person employed as a lifeguard
- 17 by a county of this State.
