A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE HAWAII HEALTH SYSTEMS CORPORATION.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. The legislature recognizes the need to expand 2 cardiac care to the neighbor islands. There have been many 3 instances where heart attack victims are unable to receive crucial life-saving care within the "golden hour" from the onset 4 5 of a heart attack during which death will occur if proper treatment is not received. Irreversible damage to the heart can 6 7 occur within just six hours after the blood supply to the heart 8 is impeded.

9 Accordingly, the purpose of this Act is to appropriate 10 funds for the establishment of a full-time catheterization 11 laboratory, including employment of staff, at the Hilo medical 12 center in the Hawaii health systems corporation east Hawaii 13 region.

SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$\$\$ or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year

5 The sums appropriated shall be expended by the Hawaii
6 health systems corporation for the purposes of this Act.
7 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
