BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. Section 269-2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 2 amended by amending subsection (b) to read as follows:
- 3 "(b) Effective July 1, 2005, the chairperson of the
- 4 commission shall be paid a salary set at eighty-seven per cent
- 5 of the salary of the director of human resources development,
- 6 and each of the other commissioners shall be paid a salary equal
- 7 to ninety-five per cent of the chairperson's salary. The
- 8 commissioners shall be exempt from chapters 76 and 89 but shall
- 9 be members of the state [+] employees'[+] retirement system and
- 10 shall be eligible to receive the benefits of any state or
- 11 federal employee benefit program generally applicable to
- 12 officers and employees of the State, including those under
- 13 chapter 87A. Effective July 1, 2019, a commissioner who is a
- 14 resident of a county other than the city and county of Honolulu
- 15 shall receive, in addition to actual travel expenses, a per diem
- 16 allowance to cover personal expenses such as board, lodging, and

- 1 incidental expenses of \$225 per day authorized by the
- 2 commission."
- 3 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 4 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on January 1, 2050.
