### A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT.

### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The Hawaii Revised Statutes is amended by
2	adding a new chapter to be appropriately designated and to read
3	as follows:
4	"CHAPTER
5	STATE EMPLOYEE AIR TRAVEL CARBON REMOVAL PROGRAM
6	§ -1 Definitions. As used in this chapter:
7	"Agency" means an internal division of a branch of state
8	government, such as a department, division, branch, agency,
9	program, or office, and includes the judiciary and the office of
10	Hawaiian affairs.
11	"Canoe plants" means plant species originally brought to
12	Hawaii by ancient Polynesian peoples and shall be considered
13	native to Hawaii for the purposes of this chapter.
14	"Carbon removal" means a reduction in carbon dioxide or
15	other greenhouse gases in, or emitted into, the atmosphere that
16	is achieved by, or on behalf of, a person or entity to
17	compensate for emissions of greenhouse gases resulting from

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- 1 another activity undertaken by such person or entity. "Carbon
- 2 removal" includes but is not limited to actions that reduce
- 3 future greenhouse gas emissions or remove greenhouse gases from
- 4 the atmosphere.
- 5 "Department" means the department of land and natural
- 6 resources.
- 7 "Employee" means an employee of the State including all
- 8 permanent employees of the executive, judicial, and legislative
- 9 branches. The term also includes legislative session staff.
- 10 "Greenhouse gas" means any of the following gases: carbon
- 11 dioxide, methane, nitrous oxide, sulfur hexaflouride,
- 12 hydrofluorocarbons, and perfluorocarbons.
- 13 § -2 State employee air travel carbon removal program.
- 14 (a) The governor, president of the senate, speaker of the house
- 15 of representatives, chief justice, and chairperson of the office
- 16 of Hawaiian affairs shall establish a policy for their
- 17 respective branches of state government that requires all
- 18 agencies to participate in an employee air travel carbon removal
- 19 program established and administered by the department to remove
- 20 carbon emissions caused by air travel undertaken by an employee
- 21 of an agency in performance of the employee's official duties.

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- 1 The fee for carbon removal required for an employee trip, as
- 2 determined by the department under subsection (b), shall be paid
- 3 to the department by the agency whose employee made the trip.
- 4 (b) The state employee air travel carbon removal program
- 5 to be established and administered by the department pursuant to
- 6 subsection (a) shall include:

distance traveled;

- 7 (1) A procedure for determining the amount of carbon
  8 dioxide emissions in metric tons that result from air
  9 travel by a single airline passenger, based on the
  10 average fuel consumption and corresponding carbon
  11 dioxide emission per kilometer traveled for the
  12 aircraft in which the single airline passenger
  13 traveled, passenger capacity of the aircraft, and
  - (2) Carbon dioxide-reducing projects to be implemented by or on behalf of the department from fees required under this section, which may include but not be limited to projects for the reforestation of degraded areas of Hawaii by planting trees native to Hawaii such as koa varieties, sandalwood varieties including

1		Iliahi, Laauala, Wahieala, Aoa, Aahi, and canoe
2		plants;
3	(3)	A methodology to determine the:
4		(A) Amount in metric tons of carbon dioxide, or the
5		carbon dioxide equivalent of other greenhouse
6		gases, to be eliminated from future emissions or
7		to be absorbed from the atmosphere by carbon
8		removal program projects; and
9		(B) Cost, including materials, labor, and
10		administrative costs, per unit metric ton of
11		carbon dioxide reduction;
12	(4)	A procedure, based on the information developed
13		through paragraphs (1) to (3), for calculating the fee
14		to be assessed to an agency for the amount of carbon
15		removal in metric tons that is equivalent to the
16		amount of carbon dioxide emissions attributable to a
17		specific airline trip by an employee of the agency;
18		and
19	(5)	A record system to track the allocation of carbon
20		emission reductions from carbon removal program
21		projects to specific carbon removal requests for

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1	employee trips and the remaining carbon removal
2	capacity of any project for future carbon removal
3	requests.
4	(c) Fees received by the department from state agencies
5	for carbon removal provided under this section for employee air
6	travel shall be used by the department to defray the costs of
7	projects implemented through the carbon removal program.
8	(d) In administering the state employee air travel carbor
9	removal program, the department may contract with public or
10	private entities to implement carbon removal program projects,
1	such as the planting of trees.
12	(e) The department may adopt rules, pursuant to chapter
13	91, to effectuate the purposes of this chapter."
14	SECTION 2. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.

#### Report Title:

State Employees; Air Travel; DLNR; Carbon Removal Program

### Description:

Requires state agencies to participate in a carbon removal program to reduce carbon emissions caused by their employees' air travel. Requires DLNR to establish and administer a state employees air travel carbon removal program that imposes a fee to implement carbon removal projects. Takes effect on 7/1/2050. (HD1)

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
