A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CONSTRUCTION WASTE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that it is desirable to
- 2 enhance the quality of the natural environment by implementing
- 3 sound practices that reduce negative impacts from building and
- 4 development projects. Sustainable construction practices reduce
- 5 the collective environmental impacts of the construction
- 6 process, the production of building materials, and the operation
- 7 and maintenance of the building throughout its lifespan.
- 8 Sustainable practices emphasize the preservation of natural
- 9 resources and the efficient use of construction materials.
- 10 The purpose of this Act is to require the department of
- 11 health to convene a construction waste reuse and recycling
- 12 working group to develop recommendations on how to implement a
- 13 requirement for the reuse, recycling, or donation of
- 14 construction waste.
- 15 SECTION 2. (a) The department of health shall convene a
- 16 construction waste reuse and recycling working group to

1 determine how to implement a requirement for the reuse, 2 recycling, or donation of construction waste. 3 The working group shall consist of the following 4 members: 5 (1) The director of health, or the director's designee, 6 who shall serve as the chair; 7 (2) The comptroller, or the comptroller's designee; 8 A representative from the environmental service agency (3) 9 of each county, to be appointed by the mayor of the 10 county in which the agency is located; 11 (4)A building industry representative, to be appointed by 12 the senate president; 13 A representative of a non-governmental organization in (5) 14 the reuse and recycling industry, to be appointed by 15 the speaker of the house of representatives; 16 (6) A representative from Re-use Hawaii; 17 (7) A representative from Hawaii Materials Recycling, LLC; 18 (8) The president of the Chamber of Commerce Hawaii, or 19 the president's designee; and 20 (9) A member of the state building code council, to be 21 appointed by the members of the council.

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- 1 (c) Members of the working group shall serve without
- 2 compensation but may be reimbursed for expenses, including
- 3 travel expenses, necessary for the performance of their duties.
- 4 (d) The working group shall submit an interim report of
- 5 its progress to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 6 to the regular session of 2020, and a final report of its
- 7 findings and recommendations, including any proposed
- 8 legislation, to the legislature no later than twenty days prior
- 9 to the regular session of 2021.
- 10 (e) The working group shall cease to exist on June 30,
- 11 2021.
- 12 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
