

A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO LICENSE PLATES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1 SECTION 1. Section 249-9.2, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is

- 2 amended by amending subsection (a) to read as follows:
- 3 "(a) In lieu of the number plates contracted on behalf of
- 4 the counties by the director of finance of the city and county
- 5 of Honolulu, the director of finance shall provide, for a fee,
- 6 one set of special number plates upon the receipt of an
- 7 application together with:
- 8 (1) Specific proof that the applicant was awarded the
- 9 Purple Heart by the United States Department of
- 10 Defense for wounds received in military or naval
- 11 combat against an armed enemy of the United States;
- (2) Certification that the applicant is a veteran;
- 13 (3) Specific proof that the applicant was serving the
- 14 United States in the military or as a civilian, on
- 15 Oahu, or offshore at a distance of not more than three
- miles at the time of the December 7, 1941, attack on
- 17 Pearl Harbor. Certification from the Hawaii state

1		chairperson of the Pearl Harbor Survivors Association
2		shall constitute sufficient proof;
3	(4)	Specific proof that the applicant was confined as a
4		prisoner of war while providing military service to
5		the United States;
6	(5)	Certification from the United States Department of
7		Veterans Affairs or the state office of veterans'
8		services that the applicant is a combat veteran or a
9		veteran of the Vietnam conflict, the Korean conflict,
10		World War II, or the Persian Gulf conflict; or
11	(6)	Specific proof that the applicant would qualify for a
12		gold star lapel button under the criteria established
13		by title 10 United States Code section 1126; provided
14		that the applicant shall not be disqualified for the
15		special number plates because the applicant is the
16		grandparent of the deceased member of the United
17		States armed forces;
18	provided	that applicants, except civilian applicants under
19	paragraph	(3) and civilian applicants and applicants who are
20	currently	serving the United States in the military under
21	paragraph	(6) shall also provide a copy of the applicant's mos

- 1 recent discharge paper or separation document that indicates an
- 2 honorable discharge or general (under honorable conditions)
- 3 discharge from active duty[-]; provided further that a recipient
- 4 of a gold star family member license plate shall be exempt from
- 5 paying any fees required by this section."
- 6 SECTION 2. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 7 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.

8 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
