## A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE BOARD OF EDUCATION.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECTION 1. The legislature finds that the board of
2	education presently consists of nine voting members, none of
3	whom is required to be a public school teacher. The legislature
4	believes that the board would benefit from the perspective of a
5	current public school teacher representative, to provide
6	firsthand experience and expertise on the educational climate in
7	Hawaii's public schools and to explain the resources that

- $oldsymbol{8}$  teachers need to help Hawaii's students. An appointed public
- 9 school teacher as a representative to the board will provide
- 10 insight into current and proposed educational practices and
- 11 policies and the effects of those practices and policies on
- 12 teachers, students, and the community without impacting the
- 13 existing constitutional appointment process and composition of
- 14 voting members of the Board.
- 15 The purpose of this Act is to add a representative to the
- 16 board of education by inviting the exclusive representative for

- 1 bargaining unit (5) to appoint a nonvoting public school teacher
- 2 representative to the board.
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 302A-121, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 "[+] §302A-121[+] Board of education; members; student
- 6 [and], military, and teacher representatives. (a) The board
- 7 shall consist of nine voting members as follows:
- 8 (1) One member from the county of Hawaii;
- 9 (2) One member from the county of Maui;
- 10 (3) One member from the county of Kauai;
- 11 (4) Three members from the city and county of Honolulu;
- 12 and
- 13 (5) Three at-large members; provided that the governor
- shall select an at-large member as the chairperson.
- 15 The members shall be appointed by the governor, with the advice
- 16 and consent of the senate. The governor may remove or suspend
- 17 for cause any member of the board.
- 18 (b) Pursuant to article XVIII, section 12, of the Hawaii
- 19 State Constitution, the period of transition from the elected to
- 20 the appointed board shall be as determined in section 21 of Act
- 21 5, Session Laws of Hawaii 2011.

- 1 (c) The members of the board shall serve without pay but
- 2 shall be entitled to reimbursement for necessary expenses,
- 3 including travel and board and lodging expenses, while attending
- 4 meetings of the board or when actually engaged in business
- 5 relating to the work of the board.
- 6 (d) Pursuant to section 302A-447, the state student
- 7 council shall select a nonvoting public high school student
- 8 representative to the board.
- 9 (e) Pursuant to section 302A-1101(c), the board shall
- 10 invite the senior military commander in Hawaii to appoint a
- 11 nonvoting military representative to the board.
- 12 (f) The board shall invite the exclusive representative
- 13 for bargaining unit (5) to appoint a nonvoting public school
- 14 teacher representative to the board."
- 15 SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed
- 16 and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.
- 17 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2050.
