BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 4 Statutes, is repealed.
- 5 SECTION 3. The director of finance shall abolish the
- 6 special account in the environmental management fund established
- 7 pursuant to section 342G-84, Hawaii Revised Statutes, and shall
- 8 transfer any unencumbered balance remaining, as of June 30,
- 9 2019, to the credit of the general fund.

10 SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
