BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

1	SECT	ION 1. Chapter 481B, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
2	amended by	y adding a new section to part I to be appropriately
3	designated	d and to read as follows:
4	" <u>§48</u>	1B- Charges for mileage, travel fees. No person
5	engaged in	n the business of offering goods or services for sale
6	may charge a customer additional fees for the costs of mileage	
7	or travel incurred by the person in the delivery of the goods or	
8	services	sold to the customer unless:
9	(1)	The customer receives prior disclosure of the
10		additional fees for mileage or travel;
11	(2)	The additional fees for mileage or travel are set
12		forth in the bill or invoice separately from the sales
13		price of the goods or services;
14	(3)	The person justifies the additional fees through an
15		itemization of the fees; and
16	(4)	The additional fees charged by the person are
17		reasonably related to the actual costs incurred by the

1	person for mileage or travel; provided that the
2	additional fees shall not exceed the actual costs by
3	more than per cent."
4	SECTION 2. This Act does not affect rights and duties that
5	matured, penalties that were incurred, and proceedings that were
6	begun before its effective date.
7	SECTION 3. New statutory material is underscored.
8	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
