A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO CHILD CARE FACILITIES.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

SECTION 1. Section 346-153, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is
 amended to read as follows:

3 "§346-153 Records of [deficiencies and complaints;] 4 inspections; release to public. (a) For every child care 5 facility, the department shall maintain records for the current 6 and previous two years of: results of its inspections; 7 notifications to providers of deficiencies; corrective action 8 taken; complaints of violations of rules adopted under this 9 part; results of its investigations; resolution of complaints; 10 and suspensions, revocations, reinstatements, restorations, and 11 reissuances of licenses, temporary permits, and registrations 12 issued under this part.

13 (b) Notwithstanding any other law to the contrary, the 14 records described in [this section] subsection (a) shall be 15 available for inspection in the manner set forth in chapter 92F 16 and may be posted by the department on a public website[;] in 17 accordance with this section; provided that with respect to



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1 records of family child care homes and group child care homes, 2 sensitive personal information, including home addresses, or 3 information provided to the department with the understanding 4 that it would not be publicly divulged shall be deleted or 5 obliterated prior to making the records available to the public. 6 Nothing in this section shall authorize the department to 7 release the names of or any other identifying information on 8 complainants. The department may withhold information on a 9 complaint for which an investigation is being conducted for not 10 more than ten working days following the date of filing of the 11 complaint; provided that if an investigation relates to an 12 alleged criminal offense, no information shall be released until 13 the investigation has been completed and the director has 14 determined that no legal proceeding will be jeopardized by its 15 release.

16 (c) Beginning with inspections occurring after
17 December 31, 2019, the department shall post on its website
18 electronic copies of reports for all inspections it performs of
19 child care facilities subject to this part. Except as provided
20 in subsection (b), each report shall be posted on the

15	Notwithst	anding any provision to the contrary, the department	
16	may allow	unpaid student interns, with appropriate oversight by	
17	7 department personnel, to input into reports the inspection data		
18	required	in this subsection and post the reports on the	
19	departmen	t's website.	
20	(d)	The department shall submit an annual report to the	
21	legislatu	re on all records and actions subject to this section.	



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1	For all actions that involve a complaint of a suspected		
2	violation or an actual violation discovered by the department,		
3	the report shall include the department's findings regarding the		
4	suspected or actual violation and any corrective action ordered		
5	by the department, including the suspension or revocation of any		
6	license, permit, or registration."		
7	SECTION 2. There is appropriated out of the general		
8	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much		
9	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the		
10	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
11	2020-2021 to implement and comply with the reporting		
12	requirements for child care facilities as required by this Act.		
13	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department		
14	of human services for the purposes of this Act.		
15	SECTION 3. Statutory material to be repealed is bracketed		
16	and stricken. New statutory material is underscored.		
17	SECTION 4. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
