A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO HEALTH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as the "Hawaii
- 2 Comprehensive Healthcare Act."
- 3 SECTION 2. (a) There is established in the department of
- 4 commerce and consumer affairs for administrative purposes only
- 5 the Hawaii comprehensive healthcare task force. The task force
- 6 shall review the following four healthcare issues:
- 7 (1) The adequacy of capitation rates for health insurance
- 8 plans;
- 9 (2) The unfunded liability of the Hawaii employer-union
- health benefits trust fund;
- 11 (3) Health insurance policies and coverages for treatment
- of mental health conditions; and
- 13 (4) Medical tourism.
- 14 (b) The membership of the Hawaii comprehensive healthcare
- 15 task force shall be as follows:
- 16 (1) The insurance commissioner or the commissioner's
- designee, who shall serve as chairperson;

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- 2 (3) The director of health or the director's designee;
- 3 (4) The director of business, economic development, and 4 tourism, or the director's designee;
- 5 (5) The president and chief executive officer of the
 6 Hawaii tourism authority or the president's designee;
 7 and
- 8 (6) The administrator of the med-QUEST division of the
 9 department of human services or the administrator's
 10 designee.
- Task force members may recommend to the task force
 additional members with appropriate specialized expertise,
 subject to approval by the chairperson.
- (c) Members of the task force shall serve without
 compensation, but shall be reimbursed for reasonable expenses
 necessary for the performance of their duties, including travel
 expenses.
- (d) The Hawaii comprehensive healthcare task force shall submit a report of its findings and recommendations, including any proposed legislation, to the legislature no later than

- 1 twenty days prior to the convening of the regular session of
- 2 2020.
- 3 (e) The department of commerce and consumer affairs shall
- 4 provide administrative and clerical support required by the task
- 5 force.

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6 SECTION 3. This Act shall take effect upon its approval.
