A BILL FOR AN ACT

RELATING TO THE GOVERNOR'S COORDINATOR ON HOMELESSNESS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF HAWAII:

- 1 SECTION 1. The legislature finds that homelessness is one
- 2 of the State's most significant social challenges. Homeless
- 3 persons face a wide range of issues, including general health
- 4 obstacles, mental illness, and substance abuse. The legislature
- 5 also finds that homelessness impacts Hawaii's residents and
- 6 visitors alike, and more must be done to mitigate homelessness
- 7 and its associated issues.
- 8 The legislature further finds that since 2011, the governor
- 9 has appointed a coordinator on homelessness to organize, manage,
- 10 and oversee the coordination of statewide efforts to address
- 11 homelessness. The governor's coordinator on homelessness serves
- 12 as chair of the Hawaii interagency council on homelessness, an
- 13 advisory body established by Act 105, Session Laws of Hawaii
- 14 2012.
- 15 The purpose of this Act is to formalize the position of the
- 16 governor's coordinator on homelessness by establishing clear

1	standards	of accountability and empowering the governor's	
2	coordinate	or on homelessness by:	
3	(1)	Establishing the position in statute;	
4	(2)	Requiring that the governor's coordinator on	
5		homelessness report directly to the governor, thus	
6		allowing direct access to agencies for more efficient	
7		coordination; and	
8	(3)	Appropriating funds for the coordinator position and	
9		other associated expenses, including the hiring of	
10		necessary staff.	
11	SECT	ION 2. Chapter 346, Hawaii Revised Statutes, is	
12	amended b	y adding a new section to part XVII to be appropriately	
13	designated and to read as follows:		
14	" <u>§34</u>	6- Governor's coordinator on homelessness;	
15	establish	ment; responsibilities. (a) There is established	
16	within the department for administrative purposes only, a		
17	governor's coordinator on homelessness to organize, manage, and		
18	oversee t	he coordination of statewide efforts to end	
19	homelessness. The governor's coordinator on homelessness shall		
20	report di	rectly to the governor and shall:	

1	(1)	Serve as the principal officer in state government
2		responsible for the performance, development, and
3		oversight of programs, policies, and activities
4		relating to homelessness;
5	(2)	Be responsible for ensuring the development,
6		implementation, and management of plans developed by
7		the Hawaii interagency council on homelessness
8		pursuant to section 346-381;
9	(3)	Coordinate with the homeless coordinator of each
10		county to ensure statewide coordination, minimize
11		duplication of efforts, and monitor and benchmark
12		progress on the mitigation and management of
13		homelessness in each county;
14	(4)	Communicate with departments and agencies that provide
15		rental subsidies and housing assistance; and
16	(5)	Develop and implement plans to increase affordable
17		housing units through the identification of viable
18		lands and supporting housing projects to ensure
19		coordination and collaboration.
20	(b)	The governor's coordinator on homelessness shall:
21	(1)	Employ persons evempt from chapters 76 and 89, and

1	(2) Adopt rules pursuant to chapter 91 necessary for the		
2	purposes of this section.		
3	(c) The office of the governor shall provide office space		
4	to the governor's coordinator on homelessness and related staff;		
5	provided that if the office of the governor is unable to provide		
6	adequate office space, the department shall provide adequate		
7	office space to the governor's coordinator on homelessness and		
8	related staff."		
9	SECTION 3. There is appropriated out of the general		
10	revenues of the State of Hawaii the sum of \$ or so much		
11	thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year 2019-2020 and the		
12	same sum or so much thereof as may be necessary for fiscal year		
13	2020-2021:		
14	(1) To establish the governor's coordinator on		
15	homelessness as a full-time equivalent position; and		
16	(2) For other expenses of the governor's coordinator on		
17	homelessness, including the hiring of necessary staff.		
18	The sums appropriated shall be expended by the department		
19	of human services for the purposes of this Act.		
20	SECTION 4 New statutory material is underscored.		

SECTION 5. This Act shall take effect on July 1, 2019.
